

Guidelines and applying for funding

The Adelaide Bank Charitable Foundation can consider the provision of funding for your organisation providing it has Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) status.

This status is determined by the Australian Tax Office. You can check the DGR status of an organisation by searching the Australian Business Register at www.abr.business.gov.au or by phoning the Australian Tax Office on 1300 130 248.

The Foundation considers applications for any project or program that demonstrates a benefit to the community, particularly where there is a direct benefit to the disadvantaged including:

- Specific items contributing to community events
- Cultural, artistic, educational programs/events
- Equipment e.g. medical, sporting, office
- Personal development programs.

Please note the Governors are unable to consider requests for the following:

- Ongoing administration costs, such as staff wages
- Applications for the benefit of an individual
- Projects that are for an organisation's core business purposes
- Donations to general appeals, sponsorships or other general funding foundations
- Capital items that would normally be funded wholly through government sources
- Projects that require recurrent funding
- Projects outside of South Australia.
